What is Poverty?

Deficiency of resources needed or desired

Poverty is Lack of:

- Not just lack of Resources, Money \$ (basic needs, food, home..)
- But also lack of Education/knowledge/Spirituality
- Lack of Relationship, Love
- Lack of Contentment, Calmness, Good company
- And Lack of basic values, ethics

"Lack of health, wealth, and peace is poverty"



Causes and Effects of Poverty

India is NOT a Poor County

- CORRUPTION: greed, ego (Gita. 16.21, 2.62.63)
- Lack of <u>Dharma/ethics/basic values (Adharma)</u>
- Injustice to others
- Unequal distribution of income/resources
- Stress, Diseases, Relationship, Health problems
- Social and global problems

When immortality and unrighteousness prevails, people become corrupt and social problem arise (Gita)

Disturbances in the world

What is **Dharma**?

- Codes of righteous living are followed (Righteousness)
- Own prescribed duty (Svadharma) is fulfilled
- Ethical behavior is practiced.
- Example: Arjuna

Opposite of Dharma is adharma





Dharma and Adharma

Sharing with others is Dharma, but snatching from others is adharma Respecting others needs is Dharma But insulting & hurting others is adharma, **Loving others is Dharma** but hating others is adharma, **Greed and using natural recourses without** concern for others is adharma




